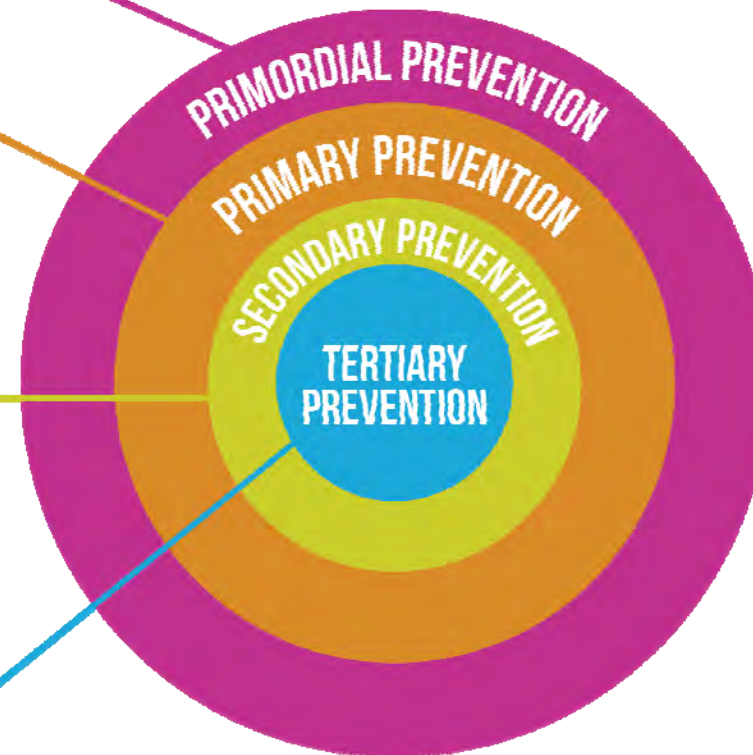

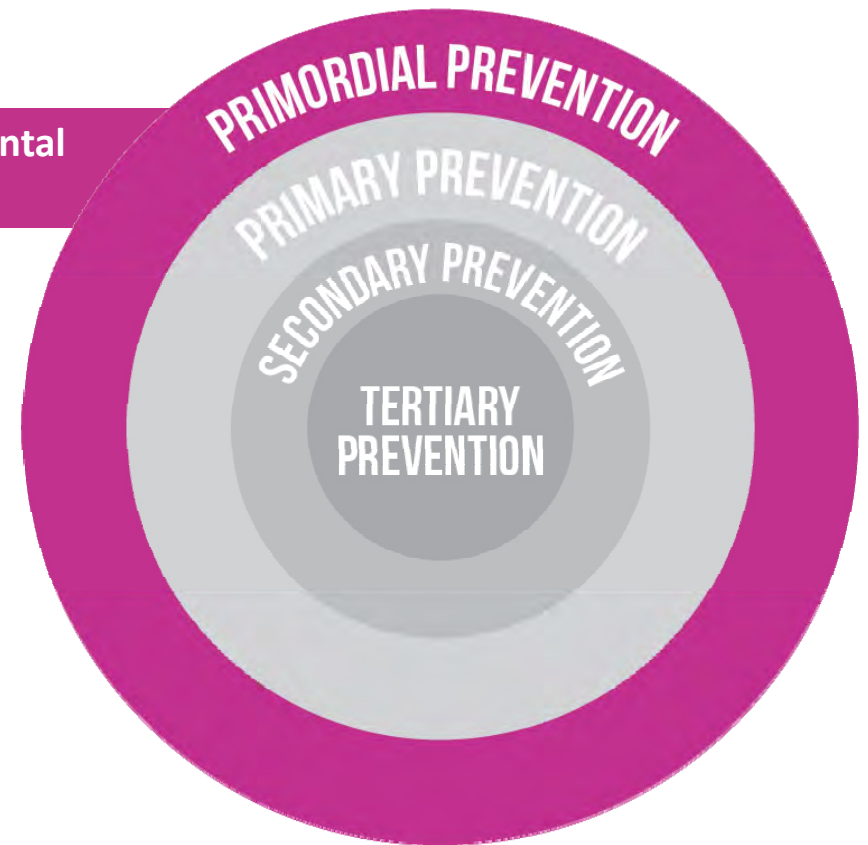


Primordial prevention

Creating a safer environment

Preventing the emergence of predisposing social and environmental conditions that lead to harm

- Reduce health and social inequalities
- Reduce gender inequalities



Primary prevention

Improving outcomes across the community

Reducing the average risk of harm among the whole population

- Conduct public education campaigns on alcohol-related family and domestic violence and ways to prevent these harms
- Reduce the physical availability of alcohol
- Reduce the economic availability of alcohol
- Regulate the promotion of alcohol

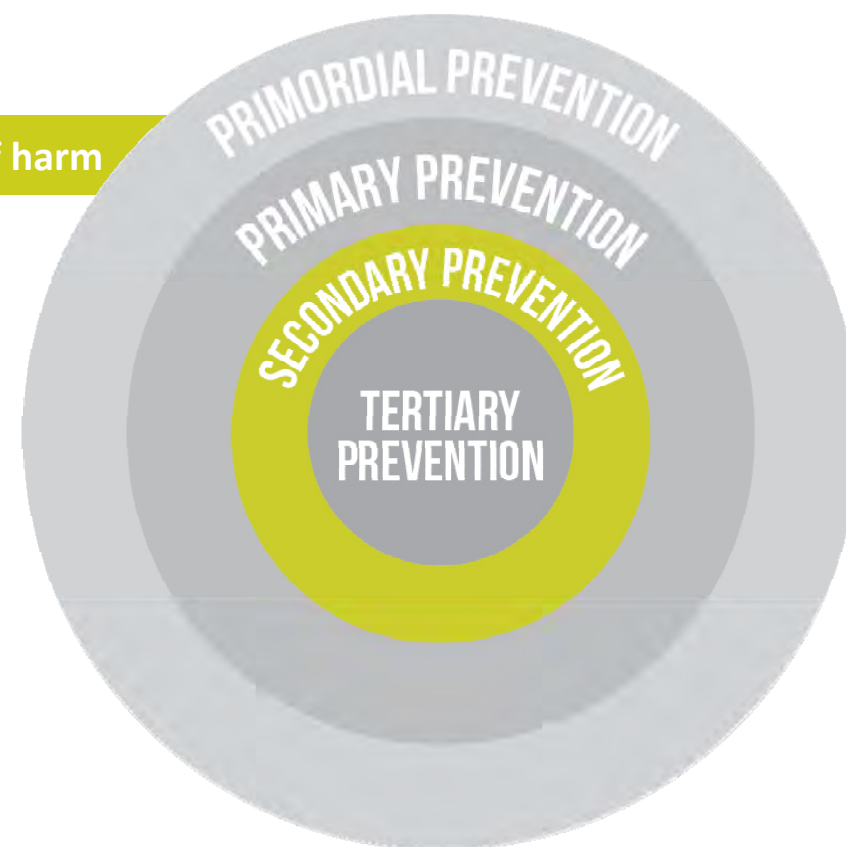


Secondary prevention

Focusing on people at greater risk

Early detection and intervention among people at greater risk of harm

- Identify children and young people at risk of child maltreatment
- Implement and fund family centred programs for people affected by alcohol and substance misuse
- Reduce the prevalence of alcohol-related family and domestic violence among Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples
- Undertake opportunistic screening with people at greatest risk of harm

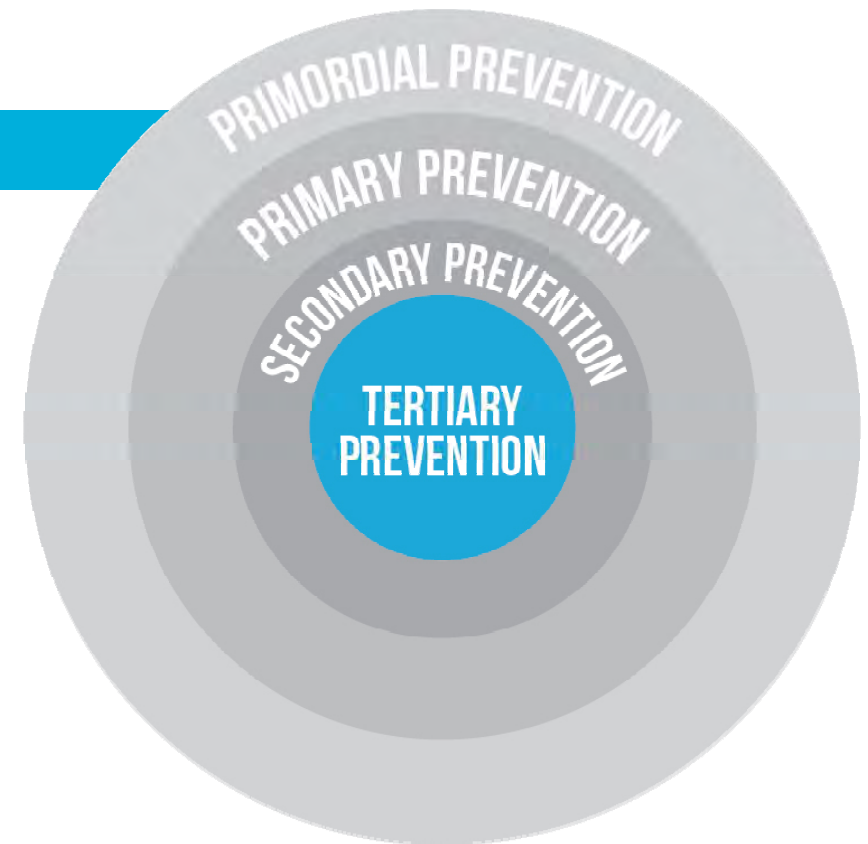


Tertiary prevention

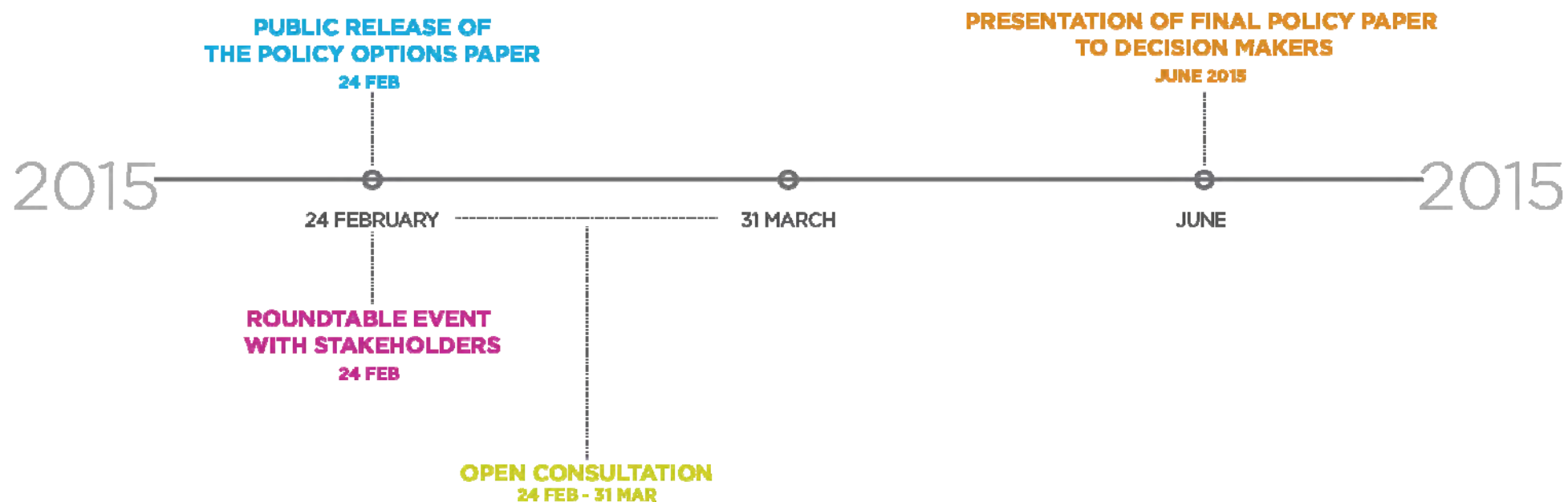
Protecting people from further harm

Preventing the recurrence of harm

- Develop of a comprehensive Model of Care for alcohol-related family and domestic violence
- Provide adequate and ongoing funding to alcohol and other drug services and family and domestic violence services
- Increase coordination between alcohol and other drug services and child protection services
- Implement programs targeted at perpetrators
